

Central Campus Course Requests – Round 2

The Central Campus (CC) course request link will re-open the morning of March 21, 2022. This document will provide helpful information for those wishing to request a class at Central Campus for the 2022-23 school year. (This is only for NEW requests. If you have already submitted a request for a CC course/s in the fall and been offered a spot in the course or on the waitlist, you do NOT need to request the same course again.)

- Previously used links and QR codes from earlier in the year will not be used. The new links and codes will be shared below.
- To have student voice in this process, students (not parents) should be making the request.
- If a class does not appear on this new survey, the class is filled with a large waitlist.
- We will run results on a bi-weekly basis through the end of the school year. We will notify the student and the home high school counselor about results. Students may accept the seat or decline the seat at that time.
- If a student declines the seat, the seat offer is removed and presented to another student on the waitlist.
- Students on a waitlist are in position order. Students will be offered seats in the order they appear on the waitlist. We will not share which position a waitlisted student is on.
- We will work with your child's home high school counselor to create a schedule between buildings without time gaps. Parents do not need to call to ensure this happens.

Important Points for Non-DMPS students:

- Before making a request, you should seek approval from your home high school principal or school counselor to take coursework at Central Campus along with the school district sharing tuition costs with DMPS.
- When accepting a seat in a CC program, soon after a parent/guardian must complete the DMPS OLR (an online form). Mary Moua will contact families with next steps. If a family does not fully complete the DMPS OLR, a student will not be able to start classes with us.
- DMPS does not provide transportation from your non-DMPS home high school to Central Campus.
- Non-DMPS schools usually do not provide transportation to/from Central Campus.
- Non-DMPS schools can use a 28E Agreement with DMPS to cover tuition costs. If your district does not approve that tuition sharing request, we can arrange direct payment between the family and DMPS.
- DMPS uses Infinite Campus (IC) as its Student Information System (SIS). Other districts use it as well. IC is tailored to each school district. **Your login information for IC through your non-DMPS school will not work here.** We will issue parents and students login credentials that can be used from the DMPS IC login site. If you have not received that information after completing the DMPS OLR, please contact Mary Moua.
- **Home-schooled students or private school students** who are using DMPS Home Instruction as their primary enrollment, need to check with DMPS Home Instruction for next steps (even if the student attended here last year).
